

## Spanish War Veteran, Finis Rowe, 87, Dies

Finis Rowe, 87, a retired farmer, of Rockport, died Saturday, July 4, at the Sunset Nursing Home in Louisville after a lingering illness. He was a veteran of the Spanish American War.

Mr. Rowe was born November 16, 1876 and was a son of the late William I. and Martha Baker Rowe.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Eva Renfrow, of Louisville; three sons, Frank Rowe, of Route 1, Rockport, Lon Rowe, of Hammond, Indiana, and Fon Rowe, of Menomonee Falls, Wisconsin; one sister, Mrs. Lillie Duncan, of Los Angeles, California; 14 grandchildren, and 16 great-grandchildren.
