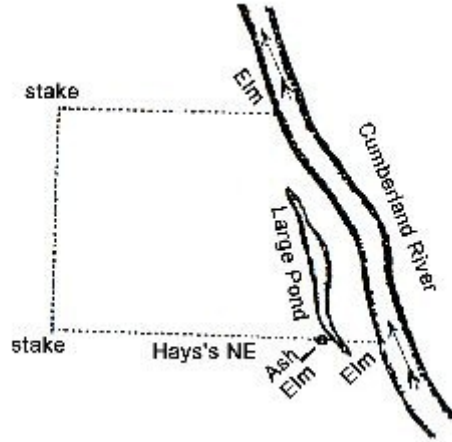


**Done By a Scale of two
hundred Poles to an Inch**



**Davidson County, Tn
November 26th 1785**

Surveyed for Peter Rentfro ___ ___ Six hundred & fourty acres of land agreeable to the inclosed warrant No 581. (this Entry dated August 17th 1784 ___ ___) of which the above is a true Platt bounded as follows.

Beginning at an Ash & Elm William Hays's Northeast Corner running East Seventy Poles to an Elm & two Beech's on the bank of Cumberland River -- thence down said River according to its several Courses three hundred & twenty-eight Poles to an Elm & Beech -- thence West two hundred & seventy-one Poles to a Stake - thence South two hundred & eighty-six Poles to a Stake - thence East three hundred & fourty-two Poles to the Beginning.
